Program Description: The Ornamental Horticulture department features many short certificates. These certificates are made up of clusters of related courses that can prepare students for specific work-related job functions.

Credit/Grade Requirements All required credits must be earned at Edmonds Community College. Students are required to maintain a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.0 in all college-level courses as well as a minimum grade point average of 2.8 within the program requirements.

Students Are Advised To

1. Plan their schedule several quarters in advance in order to accommodate courses that are offered only once or twice a year
2. Review the college catalog for required course prerequisites and include these in schedule planning
3. Communicate with a faculty adviser
