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**Program Description:** The Ornamental Horticulture department features many short certificates. These certificates are made up of clusters of related courses that can prepare students for specific work-related job functions.

Credit/Grade Requirements All required credits must be earned at Edmonds Community College. Students are required to maintain a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.0 in all college-level courses as well as a minimum grade point average of 2.8 within the program requirements.

- Plan their schedule several quarters in advance in order to accommodate courses that are offered only once or twice a year
- Review the college catalog for required course prerequisites and include these in schedule planning
